## Refugee reception in Europe: A year after TPD, conditions and challenges

About a year ago, the EU Temporary Protection Directive (TPD) was activated for the first time. Why is this directive so unique and central to understand the challenges of refugee reception in Europe? How can we describe the preconditions of refugee reception before its activation? The TPD has been extended until March 2024, what can we expect to happen after that and how do we prepare for various scenarios?

In the spirit of the Swedish EU presidency, the Migration Studies Delegation (Delmi) and the European Migration Network (EMN) in Sweden invite to a half day conference to learn more about the preconditions, experiences, and challenges behind the Temporary Protection Directive.
